

Ryan Wilcoxen Memorial Scholarship Application

The Ryan Wilcoxen Memorial Scholarship is named in honor of Ryan Wilcoxen, a 2008 Eastern Greene High School alumni. Ryan was a standout athlete at Eastern, leading the baseball program to its only semi-state appearance in school history. Ryan continued to play baseball at Franklin College, while earning a degree in physical education and health. Ryan spent his career teaching and coaching students in numerous districts in central Indiana, but found his home at Owen Valley High School. Ryan led a life of continual impact on those around him, making it only suitable that his family honor him by awarding a graduating senior who will also lead a life of impact.

The Ryan Wilcoxen Memorial Scholarship committee is currently accepting applications. The scholarships of \$4,000 for college or post-secondary technical schooling are awarded to one Eastern Greene High School senior athlete and one Owen Valley High School senior athlete. Application guidelines and instructions are included in this announcement.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS April 12, 2024.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Guidelines and Instructions

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for consideration, scholarship applicants must:

- * Be an EGHS or OVHS senior.
- ✤ Be a four year athlete.
- * Plan to pursue an education, either full-time or part-time, in any accredited post-secondary institution.
- * Be a U.S. citizen, or documented permanent resident of the U.S. Race, color, creed or sex will not be factors in choosing the Award winner(s).
- * Be a registered organ donor in the state of Indiana.
- * CANNOT be a fan of the University of Michigan.
- * Recipients will be asked to provide proof of acceptance to a college or university before receiving payment of the Award.

Application Submission Instructions:

In order to be eligible for consideration, scholarship applications must:

- * Be typed (preferred) or printed in blue or black ink on only one side of the page. Essays <u>must</u> be typed.
- ★ Be clearly legible and submitted in English.
- * Be submitted in hard copy to the respective high school guidance office.
- ★ Be submitted in the same order as received. Applications may be paper clipped in their entirety, but please do not separate/group parts of the application by paper clipping or stapling certain sections.
- ★ Include current and accurate contact information.
- * Provide all signatures where indicated on the application.

Application Timeline:

- April 12, 2024: Completed applications and all supporting materials.
- April 15-26, 2024: Scholarship committee meets and deliberates to determine winners.

Winners will be notified at their respective senior award nights during the first week of May, 2024.
